A brand founded by two tailors in Washington, D.C., in 1917.

Samuel Gilbert Shendow, who left Greensburg, Pennsylvania after graduating from high school, made his way to Washington, D.C., by 1919 — following stops in Boston, New York, Philadelphia, and Richmond. Soon after his arrival in the Capital, he was hired by The Bell Clothes Shop and its ever-expanding franchise, which at the time boasted two stores in Washington, D.C.; two in New York City; and one each in Baltimore, Norfolk, Chattanooga, and Pittsburgh.

By 1925, Samuel Gilbert Shendow set out on his own, chartering a new business with the encouragement and support of the original founders. The Bell Clothes brand made its Shenandoah Valley debut on October 31, 1925, in Front Royal, Virginia. On the eve of the grand opening, Samuel celebrated in style — hosting an orchestra in front of the new store. For several years, the Front Royal location commanded his full attention until the Great Depression struck. Forced to adapt, he shifted focus northward to the larger city of Winchester in 1931.

The hard times and humble beginnings were met — and ultimately overcome — by his grit, vision, and tenacity. Now, one hundred years later, we joyfully celebrate this monumental day — the day Bell Clothes first entered the Shenandoah Valley.
